Entry fee for all OPEN CLASS Exhibits, except current and active 4-H members, is \$5 per person for up to 5 entries. Each additional entry is \$1. You may enter as many divisions and times as you like. Entries are taken July 11 from 9:00 to 12:00 at the Knotty Pine in Bailey and on July 12 from 9:00 to 4:00 at the Quonset hut at the fairgrounds. There will be awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for all sections. All Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries. All Champion awards will be based on the number of entries. Awards are at the discretion of the judges.

General Classifications

J - Jr. age 14 and under

A - Adult age 15 to 64

S - Sr. age 65 and over

P - Professional - Anyone who earns more than \$1,000 per year from the craft or is paid to teach classes on the craft.

Food Special

Rules and Regulations

1. All food preservation exhibits must be labeled as follows: Name of product, date canned or processed, processing method, processing time and if pressure canned, pounds of pressure.
2. Canned Products that have not been processed by water bath canner or pressure canner per CSU or USDA guidelines will **not** be accepted.
3. Standard canning jars must be used.
4. No food items that show signs of mold growth or otherwise would not be safe to eat at time of judging or that need refrigeration will be accepted.
5. No cream pies will be accepted.
6. Use paper plates and/or cardboard boxes for display of food exhibits. Plates and pans will not be returned.
7. All food will be tasted for judging purposes.

Plants Special

Rules and Regulations:

1. Specimens must be grown by the exhibitor. House and Outdoor plants must have been owned 3 or more months by the exhibitor.
2. We are not responsible for containers, but reasonable care will be used. Exhibitor's name must be placed on the bottom of the container.
3. Exhibit specimens should be in containers that are clean and of an appropriate size for the exhibit.
4. Judging points on flowering plants: Cultural perfection, distinction of species or variety size according to species or variety, form, color, abundance, and condition of bloom, foliage and stem.
