- Barrel Race:
- Friday and Saturday (usual days and times)
- Allow no more than 12 racers (winners from each D) to start CPRA rodeos after grand entry
- CPRA Rodeos:
- Friday and Saturday evening, pre-show at 630, rodeo starts at 7. Publish as 630 start
- Livestock can arrive no earlier than 5pm Thurs. Must be finished working, feeding animals, etc. by 8am Friday morning. Arena is available for use again after 4pm. Same applies to Saturday.
- Ranch Rodeo: \$2500 sponsorship + buckles
- Saturday weekend before after parade, 6pm
- Up to 15 mutton busters
- Up to 15 mini broncs and 15 mini bulls
- Normal Ranch Rodeo events
- Charge gate: \$20 adults, \$10 kids 6-15, 5 and under free
- Band starts after Ranch Rodeo, 9pm
- Livestock can arrive Friday evening up until 10am the next morning
