Welcome to the Catch-An-Animal (CAA) Program! This program is a partnership between Park County Livestock Committee (PCLC) and the CSU Extension Office. We are excited to offer you this learning opportunity and hope that you are as excited as we are!

As a new Catch-An-Animal (CAA) family, you are certainly part of something very special. As you become more and more involved with the Park County Livestock Committee (PCLC) and 4-H, you will continue to have new opportunities – even beyond Park County – because 4-H events occur at the county, district, state, national, and even international levels! But all the fun starts at our local club level. We encourage your family to become very active with your 4-H club and encourage you to join us at the Livestock Committee meetings as well. The PCLC meetings are held on the third Monday of every month at 7:00pm at the Shawnee Community Center.

The Catch-An-Animal Committee, your club leaders and volunteers will guide you through your CAA requirements and your 4-H project with the support of the CSU Extension staff members.

Here are some of the next steps:

- 1. Make sure you enroll in the Park County 4-H Program. Enrollment will open around October 15. You will enroll through **www.4honline.com**.
- 2. Mark October 16 at 6:00 pm on your schedule for our orientation. This will be held at the Shawnee Community Center (AKA Shawnee VFW)
- 3. If you are receiving a Market Beef Project Call before **October 1** (You can call anytime now) for an initial pen inspection.
- 4. If you are receiving any of the other CAA species Call anytime for your pen inspection. Don't hesitate it is much easier to put posts and fence up now rather than when the ground is frozen. If you have questions about the requirements **don't hesitate to call!**
