## Meeting after Fair: The good, the Bad and the Ugly

- I. Johnny called the meeting to order at 7pm. Johnny Green has made the decision to step down as Fair Board President, and he appointed Adam Shirley to take his place. John motioned to officially move Adam into Fair Board President position, and Johnny will remain an alternate member. Tara second, motion carried. Adam continued the meeting.
  - A. Secretary's Reports:
    - Britt motioned to table all reports until next meeting, Jason second, motion carried.
  - B. Treasurer's Report:
    - \$216,000- total made during fair
    - \$200,000- expenses
    - \$16,000- profit
    - CTA: \$104,672.60
    - Jason motioned to approve Treasurer's Report as presented, Johnny 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## II. Facilities Report:

- Request more help from volunteers next year
- Dumpsters were not accessible, people were camped too close
- Will grade areas underneath livestock/horse tents next year
- Tom approved to hire temporary help for fair, hire 8-11 guys to help
- Add more water on Joe Linch side, near horse stalls. Build concrete slab, for wash rack, big enough for a few horses to stand on

- Parking was better this year, outline parking spaces next year? May not be able to accomplish that until the ground is in better shape
- B. 2023 PCF Royalty:

- Alice, Jolynn and Mariah thanked the Fair Board for all their support throughout their reign, they enjoyed representing the fair!
- C. Prospective Fair Board Members:
  - Shawn Rohman and Abby Schmidt both submitted letters requesting to become apart of the fair board.
  - Britt motioned to add Abby Schmidt to the fair board, Tara second, motion carried.
  - Jason motioned to add Shawn Rohman to the fair board, Britt second, motion carried.
  - John motioned to request commissioners to add additional members to fair board, to make 13 total positions, Nicole second, Britt and Jason opposed, motion carried.
  - Commissioner Amy suggested creating By-Laws again
  - Fair Board is currently an MOU, commissioners will review.
- D. Shawn Rohman (Roping):
  - 2023 Roping: \$2284
  - Gave \$1500 back to the Fair Board
  - Everyone liked the Saturday schedule better, will move up at least an hour to give more time
  - Beer garden wasn't open during the roping
- E. Kaylee Hock:
  - Renting Jeffco mutton bustin equipment was a good idea since most of ours is broken and needs to be replaced
  - Sponsor dinner was great
  - Horse stall reservation system needs work
  - Bike racks needed to be out
  - Fiber show- new, but needs help for next year
  - Change/move schedule around to make easier on kids
  - Need more help in the office
- F. Dave:
  - Suggested looking into creating private funding for fair
- G. Amy:
  - Will work on seeing how to improve shower/bathroom. Put in temporary foundation so it can be moved.

# V. Old Business:

# A. Britt:
